


Cut the strip of paper from the bottom of this page.






Twist the strip, bringing corner A to D and corner B to C. Tape the short edge together.

Fun Möbius facts!

A Möbius strip is a geometric oddity: a non-orientable object. In our three-dimensional world, objects have sides and fronts and backs, but a Möbius strip is a continuous curve with only a single side and a single edge, making it the only two-dimensional object we can hold in our hands. Even though it takes three dimensions to create a Möbius strip, any claim we make about the orientation of the band in terms of a top, bottom, beginning, or ending, is entirely arbitrary.
